

## **Phillips G. Davies Graduate Student Paper Award**

The **Phillips G. Davies Graduate Student Paper Award** is an annual award paper competition, named for the late Phillips G. Davies in 1999 to commemorate the long-term contributions of Dr. Davies to the interdisciplinary field of Ethnic Studies as well as to the *National Association for Ethnic Studies*.

**Phillips G. Davies**, was part Welsh, graduated from Marquette University in 1946 and held advanced degrees from Northwestern University. He taught in the English department at Iowa State University in Ames beginning in 1954. Although he published also articles on literary subjects, his later publications were translations of accounts about Welsh settlements, mostly in the Middle West of the United States. These appeared in the journals of several state historical societies.

### **Paper and Submission Requirements**

1. Student must currently be enrolled in school;
2. Only papers accepted for the current year NAES Annual Conference are eligible for this award;
3. 10—15 pages including work cited references;
4. MLA or APA format, 12 point font, double-spaced, 1" margins;
5. A demonstration of originality, creativity, and a contribution to the field of Ethnic Studies;
6. Papers written for class requirements are welcomed if consistent with NAES conference theme;
7. Co-authored papers will not be accepted.

Paper along with the author's contact information must be received on or before **March 1, 2012**.
