NAES Joins in Solidarity with the Ferguson Protests

11/28/2014---In response to the grand jury's decision last week not to indict Darren Wilson, the white police officer who killed unarmed 18-year-old Michael Brown, NAES joins in solidarity with the Ferguson Protests. The time has come for a moment to become a movement with the goals of justice for Mr. Brown—and others like him—an immediate end to the lethal police force so routinely targeted against minorities and broad reforms in how police departments conduct themselves.
