### **Submission Process**

1. Student must be currently enrolled in a school in an undergraduate program;
2. Only papers accepted for the current year NAES Conference and a paid member are eligible for this award;
3. The paper length should be between 10 and 15 pages including the works-cited pages; please use 12-point font, double-spaced, and one-inch margins;
4. The paper must demonstrate originality, creativity, and a potential for contribution to the field of Ethnic Studies;
5. Co-authored papers will not be accepted.

All submissions and supporting materials must be received by **FEBRUARY 15, 2018**.
